Van Jones is the Special Advisor for Green Jobs at the White House Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ). Prior to joining CEQ, Jones was founding president of Green For All, a national organization that promotes an inclusive green economy. He is also the co-founder of the Ella Baker Center for Human Rights and Color of Change, two highly innovative social justice organizations. A University of Tennessee at Martin and Yale Law School graduate, Jones is the author of the 2008 *New York Times* best-seller, *The Green Collar Economy*. *TIME* Magazine named Van an “environmental hero” in 2008 – and one of the world’s “100 most influential people” in 2009.
