



## Mid-Hudson Impact

### Lower Esopus Creek

We fight to stop the damage from NYC's muddy discharges from the Ashokan Reservoir.

### Water Quality

With the help of dozens of citizen scientists, we test the water against EPA's safe swimming standards in the Hudson and in 160 miles of tributaries, including the Catskill, Esopus, Rondout and Walkill.

### Kingston Office

We staff an office two days a week at the Hudson River Maritime Museum.

### Fracking

Having successfully kept fracking out of the watershed that supplies 9 million New York City and Hudson Valley residents with unfiltered drinking water, we continue to fight to prevent damage from hydrofracking throughout the state.

### Sewage Pollution Right to Know Act

A new law, inspired in part by our water quality data and advocacy, means treatment plants must notify the public after releasing untreated sewage to waterways.



### PCBs Cleanup

Having won the fight to begin dredging, we work with a coalition to ensure a complete cleanup to rid our fish of toxic waste.

### Pollution Patrols

Capt. John Lipscomb patrols from NY Harbor to Waterford—more than 5,000 miles annually—to investigate and stop pollution.

### Riverkeeper Sweep

In 2013, we expect more than 1,000 volunteers at 74 shoreline cleanups between New York City and Albany, and on a dozen tributaries.

### River Access

We settled a case ensuring that the public retains access to its public dock at Poughkeepsie.

### Watchdogs

Citizen watchdogs help us stop pollution in all forms, including sewage overflows in recent years in Beacon and Goshen.

### Closing Indian Point

To stop the slaughter of 1.2 billion fish annually, and end the looming risk of nuclear catastrophe, we aim to close the plant rather than license it for 20 more years.
