This letter is an addendum to the Riverkeeper and Friends of Hudson Notice of Intent to Sue St. Lawrence Cement ("SLC"), mailed November 28, 2006. Late yesterday, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Region 4 corrected its earlier statement that the SLC facility in Catskill did not have a State Pollution Discharge Elimination System ("SPDES") permit. We received a copy of the permit this morning, SPDES number NY 0006874. However, the SPDES permit does not allow for violations of state water quality standards, particularly for discharges that create such a substantial visible contrast with receiving waters. Therefore, please our notice remains in effect.
