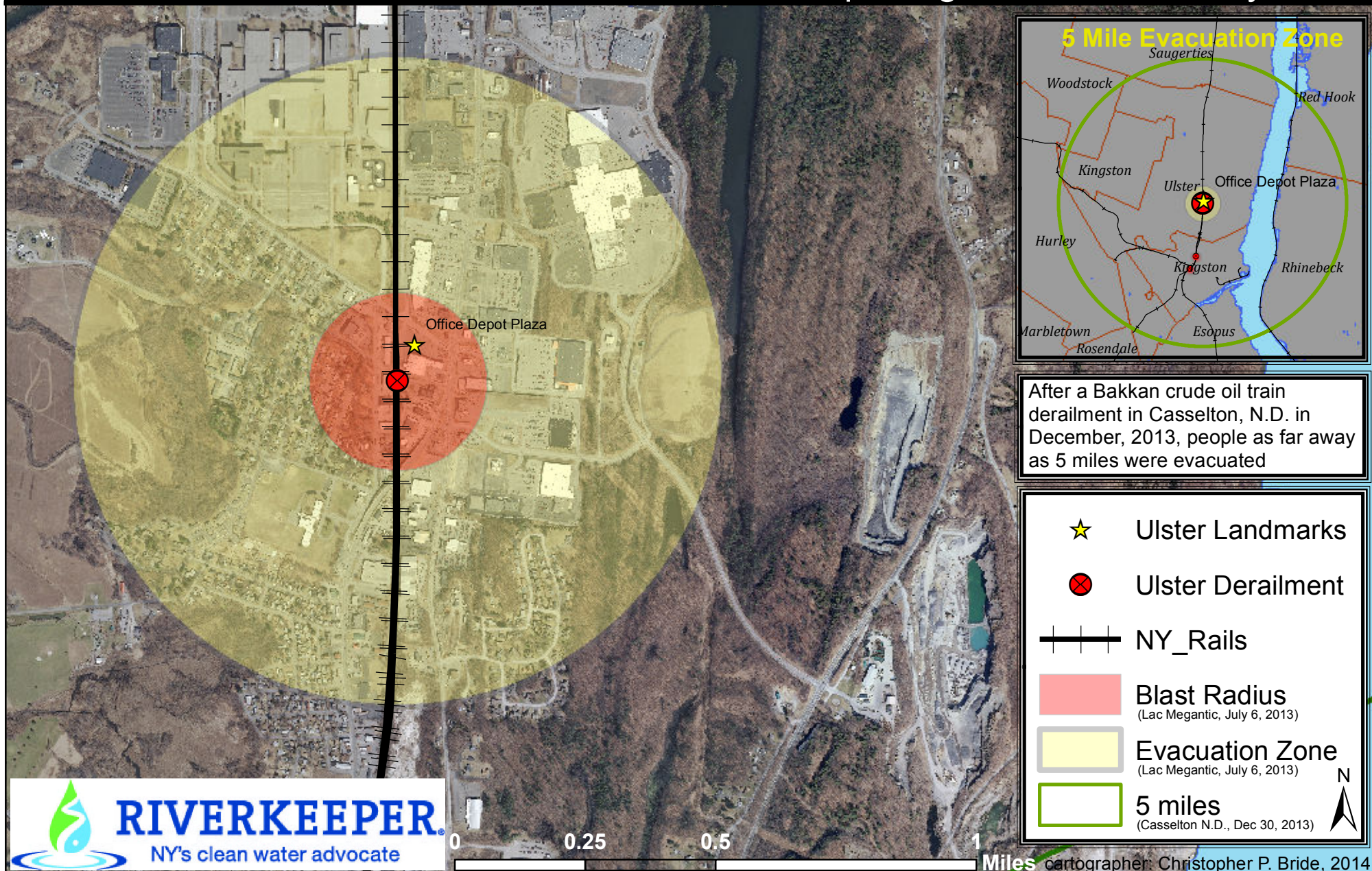


Ulster: What If it Happened Here?

A 97-car northbound freight train derailed in the town of Ulster Feb. 25. A similar train derailed in Lac Megantic, Quebec last July. That one exploded, killing 47 people in a fire that spread 300 yards, and prompted a 1,100 yard evacuation zone.
