Volunteer Role Description

Riverkeeper seeks uniquely committed volunteers to serve as **Ambassadors to represent the organization at community events with and without Riverkeeper staff present**. Ambassadors should be comfortable with public speaking and interacting with community members. Roles of Riverkeeper Ambassadors include:

- Representing Riverkeeper at public tabling events
- Assisting Riverkeeper staff in coordinating tabling opportunities as needed
- Serving as a resource for other volunteers at events

Ambassadors commit to:

- Completing approximately 5 hours of initial training/onboarding (online/phone/in-person)
- Representing Riverkeeper at 3 or more events per year.
- Attending two (2) trainings/briefings per year (online, phone, or in-person)
- Staying up to date on Riverkeeper's programs and key issues affecting the Hudson, by reading briefings provided to you and/or attending telebriefings as they're offered (online/phone)

Geography:

We welcome Ambassadors from throughout the watershed, but events are concentrated in the Lower Hudson (esp. Westchester County) and New York City areas. For this reason, we request that Ambassador applicants be willing and able to travel to events in the Lower Hudson Valley.
